Vidyavaan guni ati chatur Ram kaj karibe ko aatur	<i>Supremely learned, meritorious and extremely clever; always eager to fulfill any mission of Rama</i>
Prabhu charitra sunibe ko rasiya Ram Lakhn Sita man Basiya	<i>Fond of listening to the exploits of the Lord. Your heart is a firm abode of Rama, Lakshmana and Sita</i>
Sukshma roop dhari Siyahi dikhava Vikat roop dhari Lanka jalava	<i>In the minutest form you presented yourself before Sita and burnt Lanka appearing in monstrous form.</i>
Bhima roop dhari asur sanghare Ramachandra ke kaj sanvare	<i>You assumed a colossal form and annihilated the demons and successfully accomplished the mission of Ramachandra.</i>

Yug sahastra jojan par Bhanu Leelyo tahi madhur phal janu	<i>The sun is located at a distance of thousands and thousands of miles, yet you swallowed him taking to be a sweet fruit.</i>
Prabhu mudrika meli mukh mahee Jaladhi langhi gaye achraj nahee	<i>(Then) what is wonder if you kept the signet ring of the Lord in your mouth and jumped across the sea.</i>
Durgam kaj jagat ke jete Sugam anugraha tumhare tete	<i>Whatever difficult tasks are there in the world, they all become easy by your grace.</i>
Ram dwaare tum rakhvare Hot na agya binu paisare	<i>You are door-keeper to Sri Rama and without your permission nobody can have an entry therein.</i>
Saba sukha lahai tumhari sarna Tum rakshaka kahu ko darna	<i>Under your refuge one gets all comforts and happiness. There is no cause of fear if you are the protector.</i>

Sab par Ram tapasvee raja Tin ke kaj sakal Tum saja	<i>There is the ascetic King Rama ruling overall and sundry. And you fulfilled all his missions.</i>

Aur manorath jo koi lavai Sohi amit jeevan phal pavai	<i>(If anybody and everybody worships you) and entertains any desire he is sure to achieve the fruits of life unlimitedly.</i>
Charon jug partap tumhara Hai parsiddh jagat ujiyara	<i>Your might and glory were supreme all over the four ages (Satyayuga, Treta, Dwapara, and Kaliyuga) well-known and shining throughout the world</i>
Sadhu Sant ke tum Rakhware Asur nikandan Ram dulhare	<i>You are the protector of sages and saints, annihilator of demons and darling of Rama,</i>
Ashta siddhi nav nidhi ke data As var deen Janki mata	<i>The mother Sita granted you boon of becoming capable of bestowing eight Siddhis and nine Nidhis.</i>
Ram rasayan tumhare pasa Sada raho Raghupati ke dasa	<i>You possess the elixir of Rama-Bhakti with you and you always remain a true servant of Rama.</i>
Tumhare bhajan Ram ko pavai Janam-janam ke dukh bisraavai	<i>One attains to Rama through adoring and worshiping you and happens to forget if he had any miseries in past so many births.</i>
Antkaal Raghuvar pur jayee Jahan janam Hari Bhakt Kahayee	<i>At the time of final departure such a person goes the abode of Sri Rama and after that wherever he happens to take birth, he will be known as a confirmed devotee of Lord Rama.</i>
Aur Devata Chitt na dharahi Hanumanta se hee sarva sukha karahi	<i>A person even though he may not pay any attention to any other god, enjoys all pleasures by serving Sri Hanuman.</i>
Sankat kate mite sab peera Jo sumirai Hanumanta Balabeera	<i>All the crises vanish and all pains are removed if somebody remembers the mighty Hanuman</i>
Jai Hanuman Gosai Kripa Karahu Gurudeva ki nai	<i>Hall, Hail, Hail, to thee O Hanuman, my master be as graceful to me as my godly preceptor.</i>
Jo sat bar path kare koi Chutehi bandhi maha sukh hoi	<i>One who recites this (Hanuman Chalisa) one hundred times, he is released from bondage and experiences the Supreme Bliss.</i>
Jo yeh padhe Hanuman Chalisa Hoye siddhi saakhi Gaureesa	<i>One who reads this Hanuman Chalisa, he achieves accomplishments – Lord Siva witnesses it.</i>
Tulsidas sada hari chera Keejai Nath Hridaya maha dera	<i>Tulsidas is a servant of Lord Rama forever. O Lord, Keep your abode in my heart.</i>
